GUEST SAFETY BRIEFING

TO BE REVIEWED BY ALL GUESTS AND SPONSORING MEMBER

Firearms Act Shooting Clubs and Shooting Ranges Regulations (SOR/98-212)

- 7. (1) The operator of a shooting range shall ensure that every person who indicates an intention to use the shooting range for the first time is informed of the safety rules used at that shooting range.
- (2) No person may use a shooting range for the first time without having received the information referred to in subsection (1).

IF YOUR GUEST HAS A FIREARMS LICENSE:

Guest may shoot without direct supervision if he/she has a firearms license for the class (Non-Restricted / Restricted / Prohibited) of firearm which is being used, but may not be left unattended.

IF YOUR GUEST DOES NOT HAVE A FIREARMS LICENSE:

Guest **MUST** be under **DIRECT SUPERVISION** (within arms reach, member not shooting) of member at all times guest remains on the firing line.

ACTS AND PROVE FOR FIREARMS SAFETY

Every time someone picks up or unloads a gun, he/she will be expected to perform ACTS & PROVE.

- Assume every firearm is loaded.
- Control the muzzle direction at all times.
- Trigger finger kept off the trigger and out of trigger guard.
- See that the firearm is unloaded - **PROVE** it safe.

- Point the firearm in the safest available direction.
- Remove all cartridges.
- Observe the chamber.
- Verify the feeding path.
- Examine the bore.

ALCOHOL AND DRUG POLICY

It is the duty of every member to ensure that they and their guests are not under the influence of drugs or alcohol while on club premises.

The board maintains a ZERO TOLERANCE policy with respect to members, or guests, who are under the influence.

It is the duty of every member to immediately report infractions of this policy to the board. Members found to violate this policy may be suspended from range access indefinitely.

SAFETY RULES:

- 1. All targets must be hung AT EYE LEVEL based on the shooter's position.
- 2. Eye and Ear protection must be worn on the range at all times.
- 3. Guest shooters must be signed in and must wear a Guest badge at all times.
- 4. Always maintain proper muzzle control when shooting.
- 5. All firearms are to be uncased at the firing line only with the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
- 6. Safety Zones in the Lounge Area are reserved for cleaning and observing handguns and rifles only. (Absolutely no ammunition or magazines.)
- 7. Unattended firearms must be left on the port bench unloaded, action open, and pointed in a safe direction.
- 8. Shotguns may only be used with

- slug type ammunition.
- 9. For rifles and handguns, all ammunition is permitted EXCEPT: armour piercing, incendiary, or tracer rounds.
- 10. Targets must be constructed of paper (no glass, cans, etc.)
- 11. Targets must not be photographs of individuals (boss, ex, etc.)
- 12. Members are responsible for any damage to the target return system by themselves or guests.
- 13. Members are also responsible for damage to walls, ceiling, or floor.
- 14. Always ensure rounds are striking the backstop.
- 15. In the event that another member calls a "CEASE FIRE" you must:
 - a) stop shooting immediately.
 - b) unload your firearm.
 - c) step behind the yellow line.
- 16. Observe all rules posted in the club or on the firing line.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES:

ALERT BUTTONS - There are two emergency buttons located below the benches opposite the shooting ports. Activating an emergency button will alert EMS, Fire, & Police.

CLUB AED - An automated external defibrillator is located in the lounge area for emergency use.

FIRST AID KIT - A first aid kit is available in the lounge area.

TELEPHONES - There are telephones in the lounge and range for emergency use.
